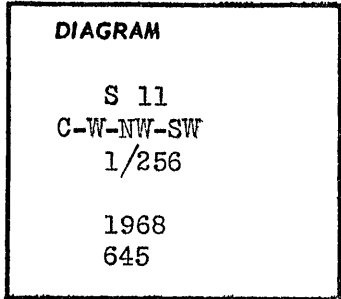


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Set two bearing trees:

A 7" lodge pole pine which bears N 49 W, 4.8 feet.

A 11" lodge pole pine which bears S 38 E, 11.25 feet.

Both trees scribed 1/256 S 11 BT.
