

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established by W. B. Barr, Deputy Surveyor General, during the original survey Contract No. 492 dated April, 1884.

Set Spruce Post 3 ft. long 3 ins square 24 ins. in the ground for 1/4 Sec. cor marked 1/4 S on W face from which

- A Fir 8 ins. diam. bears S85°E, (28.4')43 lks. dist. marked 1/4S BT
- A Fir 8 ins. diam. bears S50°W, (11.9')18 lks. dist. marked 1/4S BT

Description of corner evidence found:

A 2" length of mine rail in a circle of rocks, but no evidence of the post. The bearing trees confirm this to be the proper location.

- 8" Alpine fir (Down & Rotting Away) (Scribing Visible) (1884 BT) bears S74° 30'E, 28.4 feet.
- 8" Alpine fir (Rotten 6" Stump) (1884 BT) bears S55° 45'W, 11.9 feet.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap, marked as shown in the diagram, 24" in the ground, at the location of the mining rail. Built a mound of rock & earth to be 24" in diameter by 6" high around the monument, from which new BTs are:

- 8" Englemann spruce bears N79° 15'E, 16.4 feet scribed 1/4 S12 BT. (Unrecorded BT by Others)
- 10" Lodgepole pine bears S42° 45'W, 24.7 feet scribed 1/4 S11 BT

Attached BT and Attention signs to and painted a red band around each BT. Bearings were taken with a staff compass, using a declination of 18° 30'E, to the scribed blazes which were painted red. Distances were measured from a 60d spike, with an aluminum washer stamped PLS 699, which was driven into the side of each BT approximately one foot above the ground. Set a steel fence post 5 feet S of the corner with an Attention sign attached. The monument is not a National Forest property corner.

I, Leland L. Myers, P.O. Box 98, Sumpter, OR 97877, do hereby certify that on November 13, 1983, I re-monumented the corner as herein described.
