

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

DIAGRAM

Corner was established by James H. Hambleton, 645, during subdivision survey dated June, 1968, and an amending survey dated July, 1977.

T8S R35 1/2 E

W-E-W 1/256 S11/S14 No previous monumenting. Set a one inch iron pipe stamped as per diagram (except year was 1968 and surveyor number was 645). Set two bearing trees:

W-E-W 1/256 ---
S14

A spruce 8" which bears N30°W, 16.6 feet scribed 1/256 S11 BT
A lodge pole pine 6" which bears S2°W, 13.75 feet scribed 1/256 S14 BT

Description of corner evidence found:

1" unflared pipe with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap, marked as stated above, which was within 0.2' of the computed corner location. This corner position was accepted from which:

- 11" Englemann spruce (Good Condition) (Scribing Visible) (1977 BT) bears N30° 30'W, 16.8'
- 7" Lodgepole pine (Good Condition) (Scribing Visible) (1977 BT) bears S2° 45'W, 13.9'

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set a 2"x30" aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap, marked as shown in the diagram, 24" in the ground, replacing the previous pipe monument. Built a mound of rock & earth to be 24" in diameter by 6" high around the monument.

No new bearing trees set because others are not necessary.

Attached BT and Land Survey Monument signs to and painted a red band around each BT. Bearings were turned from the control traverse with a theodolite, basis of bearing being a solar observation, to the scribed blazes which were painted red. Distances were measured from a 60d spike, with an aluminum washer stamped PLS 699, which was driven into the side of each BT approximately one foot above the ground.

Set steel fence posts 5 feet N and 50 feet E of the corner on the National Forest property lines. Attached Forest Boundary signs to each post and a Land Survey Monument sign to the N post.

I, Leland L. Myers, P.O. Box 98, Sumpter, OR 97877, do hereby certify that on June 25, 1985, I re-monumented the corner as herein described.
