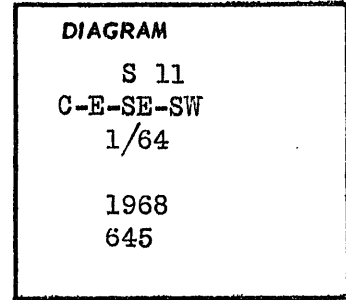


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of corner evidence found:

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

Set a one inch iron pipe with cap stamped as per diagram.

Set two bearing trees:

A 5" lodge pole pine which bears N 75 E, 11.8 feet.

A 4" lodge pole pine which bears S 54 E, 7.9 feet.

Both trees scribed 1/256 S 11 BT.
