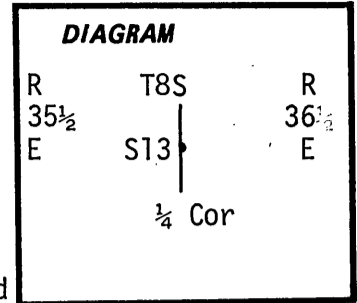


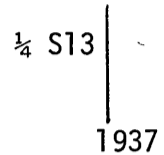
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner originally established by Eugene P. McCornack under Contract No. 398 dated July, 1881. Set post 3 ft. long 3 ins square 24 ins in the ground for 1/4 Sec cor marked 1/4 S on W face from which
 A Fir 5 ins diam bears N50° E 32 lks
 dist marked 1/4 S B.T.
 A Fir 6 ins diam bears S65° W 5 lks
 dist marked 1/4 S B.T.



The corner was resurveyed by Otis O. Gould under Group No. 179 dated July, 1937.

I now change this cor. to refer to sec. 13 only. At point for cor. Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 13 only, with brass cap marked from which
 A fir, 8 ins. diam. bears N. 50° E., 32 lks. dist., marked 1/4 SBT. Obliterate marks (old BT)
 A dead fir, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 65° W., 5 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S BT. (Old B.T.)
 A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 74° W., 30 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S13 BT. (New B.T.)
 A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 56° W., 22 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S13 B.T. (New B.T.)



Description of corner evidence found:

At the corner location I found the brass cap as set by Gould and as described above, in good condition, from which
 A fir bears S74° W 30 lks. dist.
 marked 1/4 S13 BT. Dead

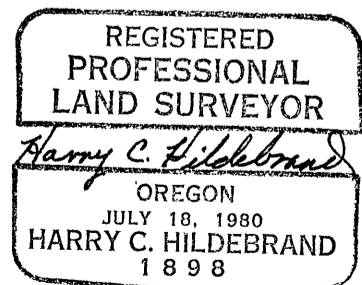
 A fir bears N56° W, 22 lks dist.
 marked 1/4 S13 BT. Alive

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

From Gould's brass cap I set one new bearing tree
 An 8" fir bears S54° W 10.47 ft. dist
 marked 1/4 S13 BT. Nail in E. base.

 Bearings taken with staff compass declination 18 1/2° East per 1980 Isogonic chart.

 Distances pulled to 60d nails with brass washers stamped LS1898 driven into side center of bearing trees.
