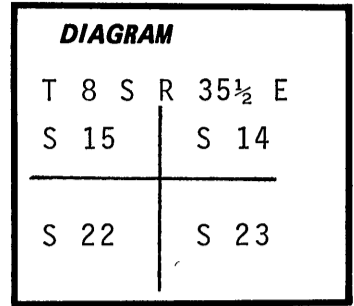


**CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

**History of original corner establishment:**

Original survey by W.B.Barr under contract No. 492 dated August 22 1883.

Set Pine post 4 ft. long 4 ins square 24 ins in the ground for cor to secs 14X15X22 & 23 marked; T8S S14 on NE, R35½E S23 on SE, S22 on SW, and S15 on NW faces with 2 notches on E and 3 notches on S edges from which;



A Spruce 10 ins in diam bears N 60 E 108 lks dist marked T8S R35½E S14 BT

A Fir 24 ins in diam bears S 15 E 42 lks dist marked T8S R35½E S23 BT

A Tamerack 8 ins in diam bears S 65 W 110 lks dist marked T8S R35½E S22 BT

A Fir 12 ins in diam bears N 80 W 180 lks dist marked T8S R35½E S15 BT

**Description of corner evidence found:**

At the corner location I found no evidence of the original post I did however find an Aluminum cap set by James H. Hambleton in 1968. I found two of the original BTs, the S 65 W bt is a 16" Tamerack standing and living with healed blazes at 72.6 ft. The N 80 W bt is a standing live 28" Fir mkd. T8S R at 118.8 ft. I also found 2 of the 3 BTs set by Hambleton. The S 26 E BT is an 8" Tamerack marked T8S R35½E S23 BT at 20.5 ft. The N 26 W BT is an 8" Tamerack marked T8S R35½E S15 BT at 16.6 ft. The N 70 W Bt is a dead and down 12" Fir marked T8S R35½E S14 BT at 9.9 ft.

**Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:**

I replaced Hambleton's NW BT with;

A 7" Tamerack bears N 35° 15' E 24.82 ft. marked T8S R35½E S14 BT nail in N base.

Bearings taken with a staff compass declination 18½ E per 1980 Isogonic chart.

Distances pulled to 60d nails with Brass washer stamped LS 1898 driven in the side center of the Bearing Trees.
