At record bearing and dist. from original SE BT, we set a 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe 16" in ground to bed rock with mound of stone and dirt to top with brass cap attached, stamped: (see corner diagram)

From Which:

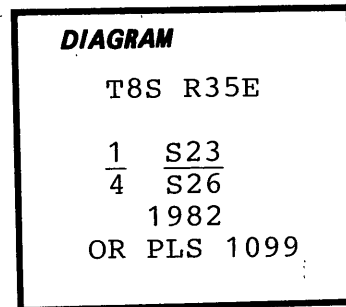
Original BT

New BT's

A White Fir 14" dia. bears N64°W 90.1 ft., scribed 1/4 S23 BT.
