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History of original corner establishment:

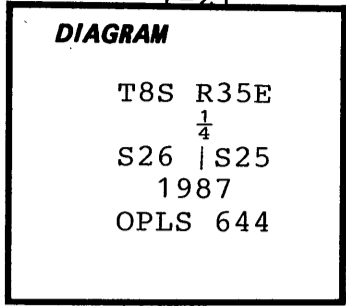
Corner history continued:

A 21 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N66°W,
28.96 feet marked 1/4 S26 BT

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 3 ft.
base to top of cap.

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and
attached 54-3 and 54-9 signs. Set a steel
fencepost approximately 5 feet North with 54-9
sign attached.
