

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

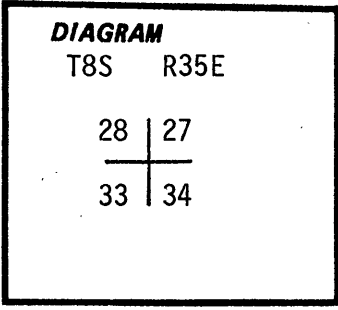
Original survey by Herman D. Gradon, Contract No. 499, 1884.
Set a post 4 ins. square and 4 ft. long 24 ins. in ground for Cor. to Sec. 27, 28, 33 & 34 from which:

A Tamarack 24 ins. dia. bears N20°E 19 lks. distant marked T8S R35E S27 BT.

A Pine 7 ins. dia. bears S51°E 20 lks. distant marked T8S R35E S34 BT.

A Pine 7 ins. dia. bears S58°W 29 lks. distant marked T8S R35E S33 BT.

A Tamarack 24 ins. dia. bears N23°W 12 lks. distant marked T8S R35E S28 BT.



Description of corner evidence found:

A Tamarack 28" dia. with visible scribing "S B" alive and in good condition bears N23°W 7.9 ft. from face of tree.

A Tamarack 32" in diameter with visible scribing "35 S 2" alive and in good condition N15°E 12.5 ft. from face of tree. No evidence of other BT's could be found.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At an intersection of original distances from both BTs we set a 2 1/2"x30" Galvanized Iron Pipe 24" in ground with mound of dirt to top of pipe with brass cap attached stamped:

From Which:

The original BT's - A Tamarack 28" dia. bears N23°W 8.9 ft. with visible scribing "S B"

A Tamarack 32" dia. bears N15°E 13.5 ft. with visible scribing "35 S 2"

New BT's - A Lodgepole Pine 7" dia. bears S 4 1/2° W 57.2 ft. scribed T8S R 35E S33 BT.

A Tamarack 30" dia. bears S56 1/2°E 73.0 ft. scribed T8S R35E S34 BT.

Attached brass washers stamped LS 1099 to foot blaze of both new BT's.

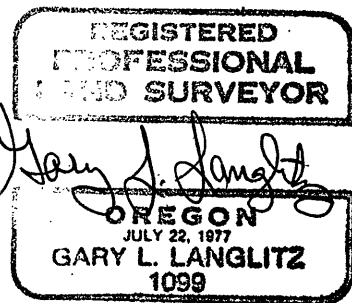
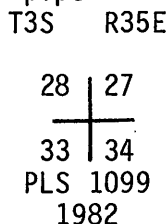
