

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

DIAGRAM

History of original corner establishment:

Corner was established and monumented by Otis O. Gould, Surveyor, during a subdivision survey Group No. 179 dated July, 1937.

T8S R36E

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 sec. cor., with brass cap marked (as shown in the diagram)

A tamarack 48 ins. diam. brs. N69°E, (16.5')25 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S8 BT

A tamarack 20 ins. diam. brs. S84°W, (32.3')49 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S7 BT

Description of corner evidence found:

3/4" pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap standing 8" out of the ground.

27" Englemann spruce (Dead)(Scribing Visible)(1937 BT) bears N67° 15'E, 16.2 feet.

21" Englemann spruce (Good Condition)(Blaze Healed Over)(1937 BT) bears N83°W, 32.6 feet. The species and diameters of both BTs were not correctly recorded in the original notes.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Maintained the mounument by making sure it was firmly set and clearing debris from the area. No rocks available for a mound, from which a new BT is:

10" Englemann spruce bears N36° 45'E, 48.4 feet scribed 1/4 S8 BT

Sawed off the dead BT about 6' above the ground. Attached BT and Attention signs to and painted a red band around each BT. Bearings were taken with a staff compass, using a declination of 18° 30'E, to the scribed blazes which were painted red. Distances were measured from a 60d spike, with an aluminum washer stamped PLS 699, which was driven into the side of each BT approximately one foot above the ground.

Set a steel fence post 5 feet S of the corner with an Attention sign attached. The monument is not a National Forest property corner.
