

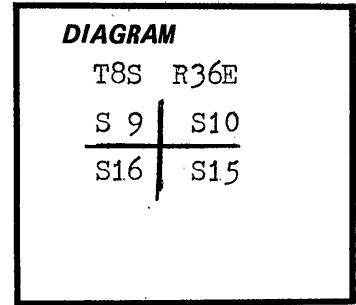
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

J-13

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Otis Gould, U.S. Cadastral Surveyor, under special instructions dated Nov. 25, 1935, during his surveys in July through October, 1937. The original notes state that at the corner a marked brass cap on a 2" by 3" long iron post was set 27" in the ground from which:

- A spruce, 24" diam., bears N.37°E., 39 lks. dist., marked T8S, R36E, S10 BT.
- A fir, 20" diam., bears S.12½°E., 31 lks. dist., marked T8S, R36E, S15 BT.
- A spruce, 18" diam., bears S.79½°W., 19 lks. dist., marked T8S, R36E, S16 BT.
- A fir, 18" diam., bears N.78½°W., 13 lks. dist., marked T8S, R36E, S9 BT.



Description of corner evidence found:

- A 2½" brass cap on 2" galvanized iron pipe protruding 9" from ground from which:
- A 28" spruce bears N.38½°E- 26.3' with scribing visible on partly healed blaze.
- A 17" dead standing alpine fir bears S.12½°E-19.8' with scribing visible on open blaze.
- A 17" spruce bears S.79½°W-12.5' with scribing visible on partly healed blaze.
- A 14" dead down alpine fir bears N.78½°W-8.6' with visible scribing.

The corner is located 30' East of Limber Creek in thicket of spruce and fir. Walk to corner from

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

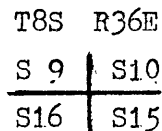
Maintained corner by mounding stones around it. From the monument:

- A 19" spruce bears S26°E-39.9', scribed T8S, R36E, S15 BT.
- A 21" spruce bears N7°W-20.8', scribed T8S, R36E, S9 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PIS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence post North of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 19° E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

The cap is a standard GLO brass cap marked:
