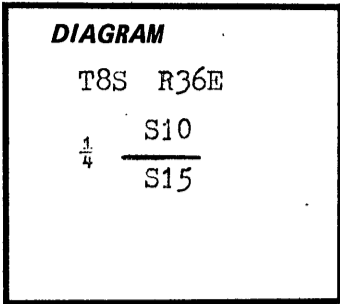


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

J-15

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Otis Gould, U.S. Cadastral Surveyor, under special instructions dated Nov. 25, 1935, during his surveys in July through October, 1937. The original notes state that at the corner a marked brass cap on a 1" by 3' long iron post was set 20" in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone to top from which:



- A fir, 8" diam., bears N.20°E., 34 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S10 BT.
- A fir, 10" diam., bears S.65°E., 57 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S15 BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

A 2½" brass cap on a 1" flanged galvanized iron pipe protruding 18" out of ground from which:

- A 11" alpine fir bears N.16½°E-22.4' with scribing visible on partly healed blaze.
- A 14" dead standing alpine fir bears S. 63½°E-37.6' with scribing visible on partly healed blaze.

The corner is located on a steep east facing hillside 530' East of ridgetop. Walk to corner from SW corner S10.

NOTE: Snow slides will probably bend monument again--it is too far out of ground for the steep slope.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

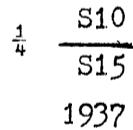
Maintained monument by building mound of earth and stone around it--pipe is bent from snow and rock slides. From the monument:

A 16" school marm alpine fir bears S42°E-60.0' scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S15 BT.

New bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence post East of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 19° E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

The cap is a standard GLO brass cap marked:
