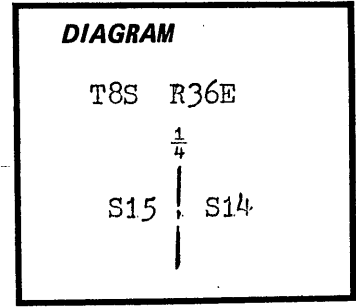


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

L-17

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Otis Gould, U.S. Cadastral Surveyor, under special instructions dated Nov. 25, 1935, during his surveys in July through October, 1937. The original notes state that at the corner a marked brass cap on a 1" by 3' long iron post was set 20" in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, from which:



- A spruce, 12" diam., bears N.69°E., 15 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S14 BT.
- A spruce, 8" diam., bears N.20°W., 8 lks. dist., marked 1/4 S15 BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

- A 2 1/2" brass cap on 1" flanged galvanized iron pipe protruding 18" from ground and 10" from a stone mound from which:
- A 10" dead, down spruce bears N 69°E-9.9' to root hole. Visible scribing on tree lying East of root hole.

The corner is located on a steep, North facing hillside. Walk to corner from NW corner S14.

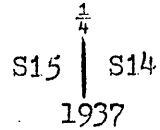
Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

- Maintained corner by shaping a mound of stone around it. From the monument:
- A 9" englemann spruce bears S.51°E-10.2' scribed 1/4 S14 BT.
- A 7" englemann spruce bears S.70°W-16.5' scribed 1/4 S15 BT.
- New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and 6" red band around each bearing tree. Set steel fence post South of corner and attached sign 54-9.

Used steel tape and staff compass with 19° E declination, measured to the center of the bearing trees.

The cap is a standard GIO brass cap marked:

This corner was maintained on July 23, 1986.
