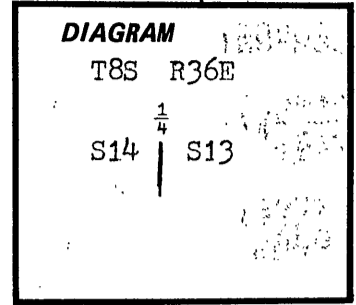


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

L-21

History of original corner establishment:

This corner was originally established by Otis Gould, U.S. Cadastral Surveyor, under special instructions dated Nov. 25, 1935, during his surveys in July through October, 1937. The original notes state that at the corner a marked brass cap on a 1" by 3' long iron post was set 20" in the ground to bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top from which:



- A fir, 12" diam., bears N.37 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^oE., 86 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S13 BT.
- A spruce, 8" diam., bears S.62 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^oW., 32 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S14 BT.

Description of corner evidence found:

- A 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " brass cap on 1" flanged galvanized iron pipe protruding 24" from ground from which:
- A 14" dead, standing alpine fir bears N.37 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^oE-56.2' with scribing visible on partly healed blaze.
- A 16" englemann spruce bears S.62 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^oW-21.1' with mostly healed blaze.

NOTE: The pipe monument is bent and cap is rotated 180^o.

The corner is located on east side of a little creek about 300' North of a road. Walk down road to line blazes then go North.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

- Maintained monument by surrounding with stones. From the monument:
- A 10" alpine fir bears N.82 $\frac{1}{2}$ ^oE-32.3' scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S13 BT.
- New bearing tree has a brass washer stamped PLS 1106 nailed to the face of blaze. Attached sign 54-3 and 54-9 and painted face of blaze and a 6" red band around each bearing tree.
- Set steel fence post North of corner and attached sign 54-9.
- Used steel tape and staff compass with 19^o E declination. The cap is a standard declination, measured to the center of the GLO brass cap marked: bearing trees.

This corner was maintained on July 25, 1986
