

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

T - 21

History of original corner establishment:

The original corner was established by Herman D. Graddon on June 18, 1884 under contract No. 499, as follows:

Set a basalt stone, 12" x 10" x 10" for the corner marked "1/4" on the west face, from which:

A 9" fir bears S57°E, 13 links (8.58 feet).
A 12" fir bears S78°W, 22 links (14.52 feet).
both scribed "1/4 S BT".

Description of corner evidence found:

The original corner stone is loosely set and has faint chisel marks. The stone measures 13" x 8" x 7", from which:

A 12" Alpine Fir snag broken off 5 feet high with scribes, "BT", visible on a partly healed blaze bears S53°E, 8.58 feet.

A 9" Alpine Fir with scribes, "BT", visible on an unhealed blaze is down and decayed. The root hole bears S83°W, 14.52 feet.

Description of monument and accessories | established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Moving the corner stone aside, I set in it's place a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe, 28" into the ground. A 3" aluminum cap attached is marked as shown in the diagram above. I bury the corner stone along the north side of the pipe and I also bury an old rusty shovel blade I found nearby along the west side of the pipe. From which:

A 24" Englemann Spruce, scribed "1/4 S25 BT", bears N25°E, 8.0 feet.
A 14" Alpine Fir, scribed "1/4 S25 BT", bears S54°E, 24.7 feet.
A 13" Lodgepole Pine, scribed "1/4 S26 BT", bears S6°W, 24.3 feet.
A 12" Alpine Fir, scribed "1/4 S26 BT", bears S87°W, 21.7 feet.
A 7" Alpine Fir, scribed "1/4 S26 BT", bears N7°W, 11.8 feet.

The new bearing trees are scribed on double blazes and have a 5/8" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636", nailed flush to the lower blaze. The new bearing trees also have a sign 54-3, Bearing Tree, nailed above the blazes and a sign 54-9, Land Survey Monument, nailed to the back.

I hereby certify the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on August 30, 1995. Magnetic declination: 20° E.
