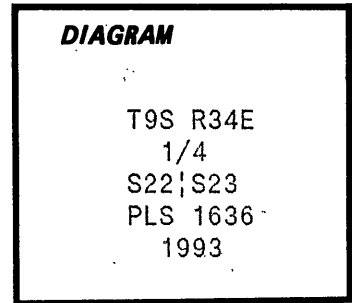


History of original corner establishment:

Corner established by Herman D. Gradon in July, 1884, under contract No. 499, as follows:

Set a basalt stone 12"x 10"x 15", 9" into ground marked "1/4" on the West face, from which:

- A 4" Pine bears S35°E, 50 lks (33.0 feet)
- A 30" Fir bears N40°W, 103 lks (67.98 feet)



Description of corner evidence found:

The original stone is gone. The corner location is on steep bedrock and the corner stone has likely rolled downhill.

A 9" Ponderosa Pine with healed blazes bears S35°E, 33.0 feet.

A 37" Douglas-fir with scribes visible on upper blaze, lower blaze healed, bears N40°W, 61.0 feet.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

It appears the original surveyor made a 10 link error in measurement to the original fir bearing tree. This tree is down a steep, rocky slope. The original pine bearing tree is close and easier to measure. At the intersection of record bearings to the original bearing trees, an at record distance from the original southeast bearing tree; set a 2 1/2" by 30" aluminum pipe 2" into the ground to bedrock. Built a mound of stones around the pipe 3'x 3'x 2 1/2' high. A 3 1/4" aluminum cap attached is marked as shown in the diagram above. From which:

A 12" Ponderosa Pine scribed "1/4 S23 BT" bears S 6°30'E, 44.5 feet.

A 16" Ponderosa Pine scribed "1/4 S23 BT" bears N 77°E, 83.5 feet.

There are no trees to the southwest.

Both new bearing trees are scribed on double blazes and have a 3/4" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636", nailed flush to the lower blaze and have a 54-3, Bearing Tree sign nailed above the blazes and a 54-9, Land Survey Monument sign nailed to the back.

I hereby certify the above corner was perpetuated as hereon described on September 9, 1993.
