

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

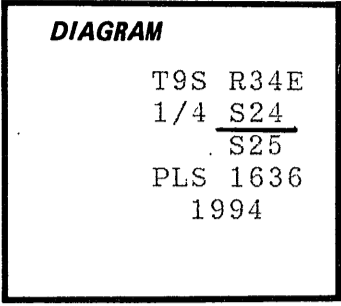

History of original corner establishment:

Original corner was established by Herman D. Gradon on June 18, 1884, under contract No. 499, as follows:

Set a post for the corner, from which:

- A 5" fir bears N10°W, 14 links.
- A 8" Spruce bears S5°E, 15 links.



Description of corner evidence found:

The original corner post is gone.

The original 5" fir is a live 6" White Fir with scribes "1/4S BT" visible on a previously opened blaze. Bears N7°W, 9.24 feet.

The original 8" Spruce is a live 18" Englemann Spruce with a healed blaze. Bears S1°30'E, 9.9 feet.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the corner point as determined by reference to the two original bearing trees, set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe, 28" into the ground. A 3 1/4" aluminum cap attached is marked as shown in the diagram, above. From which:

- A 17" Englemann Spruce bears N28°W, 18.5 feet scribed "1/4S24 BT".
- A 16" White Fir bears N53°E, 12.5 feet scribed "1/4S24 BT".
- A 17" Western Larch bears S58°30'W, 19.9 feet scribed "1/4S25 BT".

All bearing trees have a sign 54-3, "Bearing Tree", nailed above the blazes and a sign 54-9, "Land Survey Monument", nailed to the back. The new bearing trees are scribed on double blazes and have a 5/8" brass washer, marked "PLS 1636", nailed flush to the scribed "B".

I hereby certify the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on September 22, 1994.
