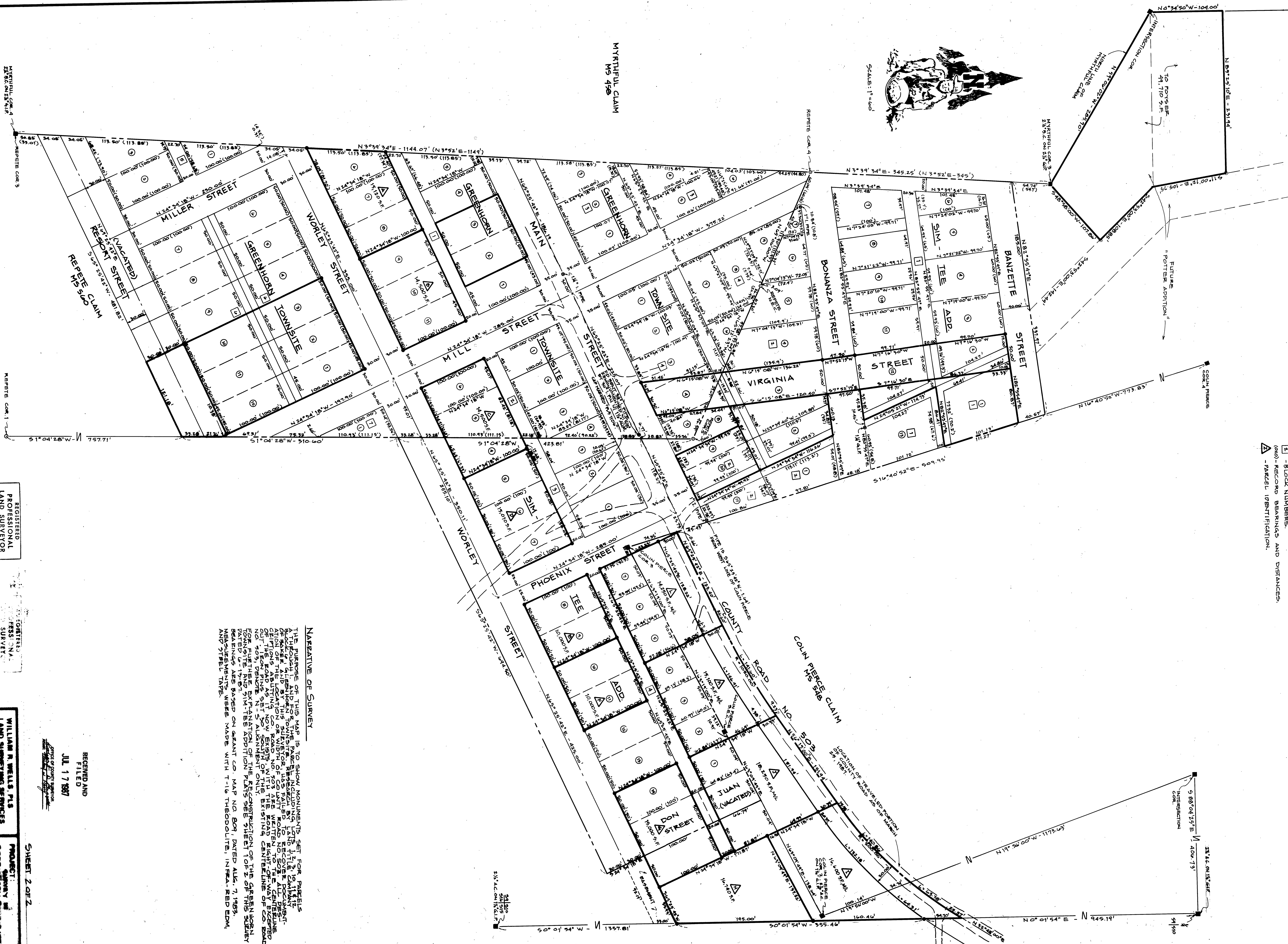




LEGEND

NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

THE PURPOSE OF THIS MAP IS TO SHOW MONUMENTS SET FOR PARCELS BLOCKED BY GREENWICH TOWNSHIP PARK INCLUDING LOTS 1123, 1016, 1127 AND 1128. THE MONUMENTS WERE PLACED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RESEARCH BY TAD BROWN, AGRICULTURAL ENGINEER, GREENWICH TOWNSHIP, ON THE BASIS OF AN ANALYSIS OF THE LOCATION OR WIDTH OF COUNTRY ROAD NO. 503. ALL DEPT. OF HIGHWAYS RECORDS HAVE BEEN CHECKED AND IT WAS DETERMINED THAT SECTIONS ALLETTING CO. ROAD NO. 503 ARE WRITTEN ON THE QUARTERLY MAPS OF THE TOWNSHIPS SET SOUTH OF THE EXISTING CENTERLINE OF CO. ROAD NO. 503, THEREIN IS ALIGNMENT ONLY.

FOR FURTHER EXPLANATION OF THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE GREENWICH TOWNSHIP PARK MAP THE ADDITION OF THE SHEET 1 OF THIS SURVEY BEING A-17-B-1.
