W.M. WAS REMONUMENTED BY OREGON L.S. NO. 1106 IN 1979. NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT USDA FOREST SERVICE REQUEST DURING JULY AND AUGUST OF 1987. THE PURPOSE OF THE SURVEY WAS TO REMONUMENT THE SECTION AND ONE-QUARTER SECTION CORNERS NECESSARY TO POST THE BOUNDARIES OF NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS IN SECTIONS 4,9,17 AND 21 OF T.85., R.27E., W.M. IN GRANT COUNTY, OREGON.

WHERE POSSIBLE, CORNERS WERE REMONUMENTED FROM ORIGINAL EVIDENCE IN THE FORM OF MONUMENTS, CALLS AND BEARING TREES. THESE MONUMENTS USED AS CONTROL POINTS IN A CLOSED TRAVERSE SURVEY USING A WILD TZE THEODOLITE AND A WILD DI-10 INFRA-RED EDM. THIS SURVEY IS DEPICTED ON THE SURVEY CONTROL DIAGRAM.

SEARCH AREAS, FOR CORNERS WHERE NO IDENTIFIABLE ORIGINAL WAS FOUND, WERE ESTABLISHED ON THE BASIS OF THIS SURVEY AND G.L.O. RECORD DATA. EACH OF THESE CORNERS WAS SEARCHED DILIGENTLY, BUT NO ADDITIONAL EVIDENCE WAS FOUND. THESE CORNERS, THE ONE-QUARTER SECTION CORNERS BETWEEN SECTIONS 3\$4, 9\$10 AND 16\$17. WERE REMONUMENTED BY SINGLE PROPORTIONMENT BETWEEN THE TWO ADJACENT SECTION CORNERS, BASED ON THE SURVEY, MANUAL INSTRUCTIONS, AND CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS. THE BOUNDARIES OF NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS WERE POSTED WITH 6 FOOT STEEL POSTS AND FOREST SERVICE BOUNDARY SIGNS.

THE FOLLOWING INDICATORS OF POSSIBLE ENCROACHMENT UPON NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS WERE OBSERVED AND DISPLAYED ON THE MAP ABOVE. FENCES WERE FOUND ALONG THE ENTIRE LENGTH OF THE POSTED LINE. IT IS NOT KNOWN WHO CONSTRUCTED THE FENCES, BUT FOR ALMOST THEIR ENTIRE LENGTH, THEY WERE ON NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS. FROM ZERO TO 400 FEET. MANY NO TRESS PASSING SIGNS WERE FOUND ALONG THE FENCE LINE. SOME TIMBER CUTTING WAS DONE DURING JULY ON THE LANDS ALONG THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN SECTIONS 3 AND 4. SOME PINES, WITH AN ESTIMATED AVERAGE DBH OF 30", WERE TAKEN FROM THE FOREST SERVICE SIDE OF THE POSTED LINE FOR PART OF IT'S LENGTH, BUT IS ONLY ACCESSIBLE FROM ADJACENT PRIVATE LANDS.
