NARRATIVE: This survey was made at the request of the Grant County Court. The purpose of this survey is to establish a boundary agreement line along a portion of County Road No. 82, between Barney Pereira and the County, also to place a brass cap monument in the center of said county road at the northerly right of way line of U.S. Highway 26, as shown hereon.

The agreement between the Grant County Court and Barney Pereira is of record in Commissioners Journal W, Page 766-767.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments. The new monument was set in accordance with the evidence found as shown.

The monuments found along the east side of County Road No. 82 are along an existing fence line. These monuments were set in 1979 as shown on Record Map of Survey No. 545.
