NARRATIVE	TO	ACCOMPANY	PLAT

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO MARK BOUNDARY LINES BETWEEN NATIONAL FOREST LAND AND PRIVATELY OWNED LAND IN AND ADJOINING SECTIONS 17, 18, 19, AND 20, T 10 S, R 33 E, W.M. THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF U.S.D.A. FOREST SERVICE, MALHEUR NATIONAL FOREST UNDER CONTRACT NO. 53-04H1-7-4011, SUN CADASTRAL SURVEY.

HISTORY - THE WEST LINE AND SUBDIVISION OF THE TOWNSHIP WERE SURVEYED IN 1881 BY H. GRADON UNDER CONTRACT NO 383. SECTION 19 AND THE WEST HALF OF SECTION 20 WAS SURVEYED IN 1978 BY DOUGLAS FERGUSON (CS 529). THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTIONS 19 AND 20, AND THE EAST LINES OF SECTION 20 WAS SURVEYED IN 1978 AND 1980 BY FERGUSON FOR THE FOREST SERVICE (CS 624). CERTAIN OTHER CORNERS OF THESE SECTIONS HAVE BEEN REMONUMENTED FROM ORIGINAL EVIDENCE BY THE COUNTY SURVEYOR AND THE FOREST SERVICE.

SURVEY - BASIS OF BEARINGS IS A SOLAR OBSERVATION TAKEN AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 19. CLOSED RANDOM TRAVERSES WERE RUN AROUND THE EXTERIORS OF THE SECTIONS AS REQUIRED FOR SUBDIVISION AND POSTING, TYING TO THE EXISTING CORNERS SHOWN. CLOSED LOOP RANDOM TRAVERSE WERE RUN THROUGH THE INTERIOR OF THE SECTIONS, GENERALLY ALONG THE PROPERTY BOUNDARY LINES, FOR POSTING AND INTERNAL MONUMENTATION PURPOSES.

SURVEY AND SUBDIVISION OF THE SECTION WAS CONDUCTED ACCORDING TO THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT NOTES AND PLAT, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PRINCIPLES OUTLINED IN THE MANUAL OF SURVEYING INSTRUCTIONS, 1973.

FENCELINES RUN ALONG THE GENERAL ALIGNMENT OF MANY OF THE BOUNDARY LINES. NO OTHER OBVIOUS TRESPASS WAS NOTED. NOTES FOR THIS SURVEY ARE CONTAINED IN FIELD BOOK 7 SUN CADASTRAL SURVEY. FIELD NOTES AND CALCULATION SHEETS OF THIS SURVEY ARE ON FILE IN THIS OFFICE, AND WITH THE SURVEY OFFICER, MALHEUR NATIONAL FOREST.

GENERAL NOTES - EQUIPMENT USED - TOPCON GTS-2. ALUMINUM MONUMENTS SET IN THIS SURVEY CONSIST OF AN ALUMINUM CAP WITH MAGNET, RIVETED TO A 2-1/2" ALUMINUM PIPE 30" LONG WITH A FLARED BASE. DIRECTIONS TO BEARING TREES ARE BASED ON A SOLAR OBSERVATION. ALL BEARING TREES MARKED IN THIS SURVEY HAVE A 3/4" BRASS WASHER MARKED "PLS 1918" ATTACHED TO THE BT BLAZE. MEASUREMENTS TO ALL BEARING TREES WERE MADE TO THE CENTER OF THE TREE, UNLESS NOTED. BEARING TREES HAVE BLAZES AND BANDS PAINTED RED AND APPROPRIATE FOREST SERVICE SIGNS ATTACHED. PONDEROSA PINE IS ABBREVIATED P.PINE. UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED, PINE REFERS TO PONDEROSA OR YELLOW PINE. RECORD BEARING TREE INFORMATION IS DENOTED BY (). ALL CORNERS SET DURING THIS SURVEY HAVE A 6 FOOT STEEL GUARD POST DRIVEN APPROXIMATELY 3 TO 5 FEET AWAY WITH APPROPRIATE FOREST SERVICE SIGNS ATTACHED. BOUNDARY LINES ARE MARKED WITH STEEL FENCE POSTS WITH PROPERTY BOUNDARY SIGNS.




