NARRATIVE
THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS TO MARK BOUNDARY LINES BETWEEN NATIONAL FOREST LAND AND PRIVATELY OWNED LAND IN ADJOINING SECTIONS 12, 13, 14, 18, 19, 23, 24, 25, 26, 29, 30, 31, 35, 36. THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF U.S.D.A. FOREST SERVICE, MALHEUR NATIONAL FOREST UNDER CONTRACT NO. 53-04H1-7-4011, SUN CADASTRAL SURVEY.

HISTORY - THE SURVEY OF THE EAST LINE AND SUBDIVISION OF THE TOWNSHIP WERE ACCOMPLISHED IN 1881 BY H. GRADON UNDER CONTRACT NO. 385. THE WEST LINE OF SECTION 36 WAS SURVEYED IN 1889 BY DOUGLAS PERSSON (C5 624). CERTAIN OTHER CORNERS OF THESE SECTIONS HAVE BEEN REINDEMENTED FROM ORIGINAL EVIDENCE BY THE COUNTY SURVEYOR.

SURVEY BASIS OF BEARINGS IS A SOLAR OBSERVATION TAKEN AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 18. CLOSED RANDOM TRAVERSES WERE RUN AROUND THE EXTERTORS OF THE SECTIONS AS REQUIRED FOR SUBDIVISION AND POSTING. CLOSED LOOP RANDOM TRAVERSE WERE RUN THROUGH THE INTERIOR OF THE SECTIONS, GENERALLY ALONG THE PROPERTY BOUNDARY LINES, FOR POSTING AND INTERNAL MONUMENTATION PURPOSES.

SURVEY AND SUBDIVISION OF THE SECTION WAS CONDUCTED ACCORDING TO THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT NOTES AND PLAN, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PRINCIPLES OUTLINED IN THE MANUAL OF SURVEYING INSTRUCTIONS, 1978.

FENCE LINES RUN ALONG THE GENERAL ALIGNMENT OF MANY OF THE BOUNDARY LINES. NO OTHER DEVICES OR MARKS WERE NOTED.

NOTES FOR THIS SURVEY ARE CONTAINED IN FIELD BOOK 7 SUN CADASTRAL SURVEY.
GENERAL NOTES - EQUIPMENT USED - TOPCON GTS-2, ALUMINUM MONUMENTS SET CONSIST OF AN ALUMINUM CAP WITH MONUMENT, RIVETED TO AN ALUMINUM PIPE WITH A FLARED BASE. DIRECTIONS TO BEARING TREES ARE BASED ON A SOLAR OBSERVATION. BEARING TREES MARKED IN THIS SURVEY HAVE A 3/4" BRASS WASHER MARKED "PLS 1981" ATTACHED TO THE BT BLAZE. MEASUREMENTS TO ALL BEARING TREES WERE MADE TO THE CENTER OF THE TREE EXCEPT AS NOTED. "UNLESS NOTED" PINE REFERS TO PONDEROSA OR YELLOW PINE. RECORD INFORMATION IS DENOTED BY ().

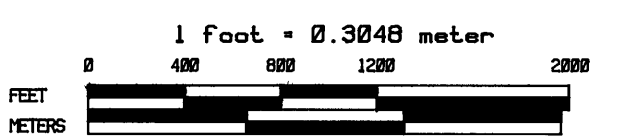

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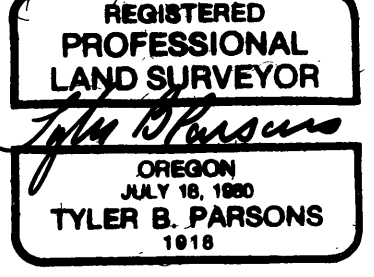
