



NARRATIVE: This survey was performed at the request of the Grant County Court. The purpose of this survey was to mark the corners of the two tracts of land which Merle Weissenfluh intends to lease to the county, as shown hereon. A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments. New monuments were set at locations approved by Mr. Weissenfluh and the County Court, as shown hereon. This survey is tied to the remonumented Initial Point of the LCI Addition, which point is identical with the west 1/4 corner of Sec. 10, T.10 S., R.30 E., as said corner is described on the recorded plat of said LCI Addition, dated August 3, 1892.
