NARRATIVE: This survey was performed at the request of Sharon Kimberling. The purpose of this survey was to mark, on the ground, the corners of the various lots in Block 59, Prairie City Land Company's First Addition as shown hereon.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments. New monuments were set in accordance with the evidence found, as shown hereon.

In our search for existing monuments, it was discovered that the street centerline monuments, set during Survey No. 491, at McCollum and Eleventh and at Overholt and Ninth have been destroyed. Their position, however, is not lost, as we did find the original monument set to set these monuments in 1877. The monument at Ninth and Overholt was found and used in Survey No. 682, in 1981. The monument at Eleventh and McCollum was last used in 1978 as shown on Map of Survey No. 500. I believe the city to have destroyed these monuments during excavation for SEWER 1188.

I used the centerline street monument positions as shown hereon for the location of Block 59 and the lots within.

The alley in Block 59 was vacated by Prairie City Ordinance No. 231, thus ownership thereof reverted to the adjoining lot owner. Eleventh Street, lying north of Block 59, however, was vacated to the school by the same ordinance.
