

NARRATIVE: This survey was performed for the Grant County Road
Department, at the request of Bob Kowing, County Road
Superintendent. The purpose of this survey was to delineate an
area for a rock pit on the Longview Ranch, owned by Robert D.
Nesen and Delta E. Nesen, trustees of the Robert D. Nesen and
Delta E. Nesen Family Trust.


A search was made of the available records pertaining to this
survey. Field measurements were made to locate the rock pit site,
the existing access easement road, the intersection of the
easement road with the Dick Creek Road, and the East 1/4 corner
of section 26 as shown hereon. This 1/4 corner is the nearest
known monumented corner. I searched for the south 1/4 corner of
section 27, but did not find any evidence of it's location. New
monuments were set at locations approved by Mr. Kowing.
