

LAND PARTITION PLAT NO. 91-3


Situated in the W1/2SE1/4 of Section 14 Twp. 14 S., R.33 E., W.M. GRANT COUNTY, OREGON



NARRATIVE

This survey was conducted at the request of Joseph W. Thompson, et al., in order to partition a tract of land for future sale. The purpose of this survey was to monument the corners of Parcel 1 only, as the exterior corners of what is now Parcel 2 have been previously monumented by a survey conducted by David E. Scott, PLS 1844, Grant County Map of Survey No. 726. In addition, easements for existing roads, vehicle turnaround and a buried water transmission line were designated. Prior to conducting this survey all appropriate records were researched in the Grant County Courthouse. The boundary of parcel I was established in the position determined by Joseph W. Thompson, et al.

To conduct this survey a portion of the north-south centerline of Section 14 was retraced; from the C1/4 of Section 14, established by David E. Scott, PLS 1844 (under Grant County Map of Survey No. 726) to the 1/4 section corner of S14 re-established by the GLO

in 1939. I find a slight difference in measurement between myself and Mr. Scott's record along this line.

The corners of Parcel 1 were monumented with 5/8" x 30" iron pins with yellow plastic caps marked PLS 2405. No accessories were established. The exterior boundaries of the W1/2SE1/4 of Section 14 were not surveyed under this survey with the exception of the west boundary. David Scott's record bearing and distances, as recorded on Grant County Map of Survey No. 726, are shown for informational purpose,

Joseph W. Thompson has been issued a "Special Use Permit" from the Malheur National Forest (User No. 5234-1) for the purpose of diverting water from Overholt Creek and transmission of said water across National Forest System Lands for use in an Hydroelectric Plant. Dennis D. Voigt has also been issued a "Special Use Permit" from the Malheur National Forest (User No.5260-1) for the purpose of transmission of domestic water from a spring on National Forest System Lands. Both of these permits are located somewhere in the SW1/4 of Section 14, T.14S., R.33E., W.M., however this survey has made no attempt to locate these Special Use Permit's locations on the ground.

Positional control for this survey was provided by a closed traverse network. A Lietz SDM3E semi-total station was used to obtain measurements and field set the monuments around Parcel 1 from the control survey. An IBM compatible PC, utilizing Wildsoft software was used to perform the calculations. This map of survey was prepared utilizing Autocad v.10. The basis of bearing for this survey was by solar observation. The field notes and computations for this survey are on file at the office of Ferguson Surveying and Engineering, Mt. Vernon, Oregon 97865.

HISTORY OF SURVEYS

- 1880, Bannford Robb conducted the original township subdivision of T.14S., R.33E., W.M., under GLO Contract No. 357.
- 1939, George Rigby, A GLO Cadastral Engineer re—established the south 1/4 section corner of Section 14 by proportionate
- 1982, David E. Scott, PLS 1844, subdivided Section 14 and delineated the National Forest System Land's boundaries for the Malheur National Forest (Hallow Cadastral). Grant County Map of Survey No. 726

STATEMENT OF WATER RIGHTS

License for Hydroelectric Project 349, issued by the State of Oregon, Water Resources Department, dated December 10, 1981, for the use of the waters of Overholt Creek and to construct, operate and maintain the project facilities for the generation and utilization of hydroelectric energy, as specified under the terms of said License.
