

NARRATIVE: This survey was performed at the request of Dennis Cawrse. The purpose of this survey wosto create a new boundary line between the lands of Dennis and Joanne Cawrse, husband and wife and the lands of Dennis and Joanne Cawrse. husband and wife, each as to an undivided one half interest, as tenants in common and not as tenants by the entirety, as shown hereon. Also, to establish and set the NW 1/16 corner of section 11 and to establish and set the C-E-NW 1/64 corner of Section 11, and to mark the line from said 1/64 corner to the North 1/4 corner of said Section 11, and from said 1/64 corner to said NW 1/16 corner. A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing controlling monuments. The subdivision of the NW 1/4 of Section 11, required for this survey, is based on the monuments found at the four corners of the NW 1/4 of the section, as shown hereon. The NW 1/16 corner was set at the intersection of lines from opposite corresponding 1/16 corner positions on the exterior lines of the NW 1/4 of the section. The 1/64 corner monument was set on the N 1/16 line at mid point between the NW 1/16 corner and the CN 1/16 corner position as shown hereon. A brief history of surveys follows: I established the NW corner of section 11. the N 1/4 corner, and the W 1/16 corner on the north line of Section 11 in 1986. during Survey No. 956. Douglas Ferguson, PLS 848, established the W 1/4 corner, the C 1/4 corner and the CW 1/16 corner, of Section 11, in 1988, during Survey No. 1038. In 1989, during Survey No. 1105, I subdivided the SE 1/4 of Section 11, and verified and accepted the position of the C 1/4 corner set by Mr. Ferguson in Survey No. 1038. I found no unusual conditions with this survey.
