

I, Robert D. Bagett, Professional Land Surveyor, registered in the State of Oregon, hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments, the land represented as shown on this partition plat, said partition being a division of Lot 13, Kilborn Addition to Prairie City, Oregon, situated in the SE1/4SW1/4 of Section 2, Twp.13S., R.33E., W.M., City of Prairie City, Grant County, Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 13, Kilborn Addition, said corner being monumented with a 5/8"x30" iron pin, which monument I designate to be the Initial Point for this Land Partition. said point also being 389.81 feet North and 436.9 feet West from the South 1/4 Corner of said Section 2, thence S.13°36'49"W., 155.50 feet, to the southeast corner of said Lot 13; thence S.76°23'30"W., 156.29 feet to the southwest corner of said Lot 13; thence N.13°31'34"W. 155.50 feet, to the Northwest corner of said Lot 13; thence N.76°23'30"E., 156.05 feet, to the point of beginning.

I find no record or existence of an appurtenant geodetic control monument within 1/2 mile of this land partition.

This survey was performed at the request of Mildred Newton. The purpose of this survey was to divide Lot 13 Kilborn Addition into two parcels as shown

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments, corner evidence and lines of occupancy. New monuments were set on the boundary in accordance with the evidence found, and at positions approved by Mrs. Newton on the new division line.

Kilborn Addition was platted in 1877. None of the original monuments marking this block or the adjoining blocks were found. There is no mention on the original plat that monuments were ever set. Other than Survey No. 589, there is no record of subsequent surveys of this lot. Survey No. 589, which I performed in 1979 located Lot 8 adjoining the west side of Lot 13. I retraced Survey No. 589 and accept the found pins along the east side of the adjoining Lot 8, and along the south side of Fifth Street, by which I establish the west and north lines of said lot 13. I accept the center of the lines of occupancy along Washington Street as

the best available evidence for the location of the east side of Lot 13. The south line of Lot 13 is at record plat distance from Fifth street, this is also along the line of occupancy. This survey is the result of a closed loop traverse.
