NARRATIVE: This survey was performed at the request of Kim Lemons. The purpose of this survey was to find or establish the South 1/4 corner of Section 21 and to mark, with lath and flagging, the meridional centerline of Section 21, as shown hereon.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing controlling monuments, ie, the N1/4 cor., the SE cor., and the SW cor. of Section 21. No conclusive evidence of the South 1/4 was found and after a diligent search for this corner, I declared it lost. I establish the S1/4 cor. at single proportionate measure between the found monumented corners at the SE and SW corners of said Sec. 21, as shown hereon. The original S1/4 cor. monument is probably lost to farming or ranching operations.

I found no unusual conditions with this survey.


