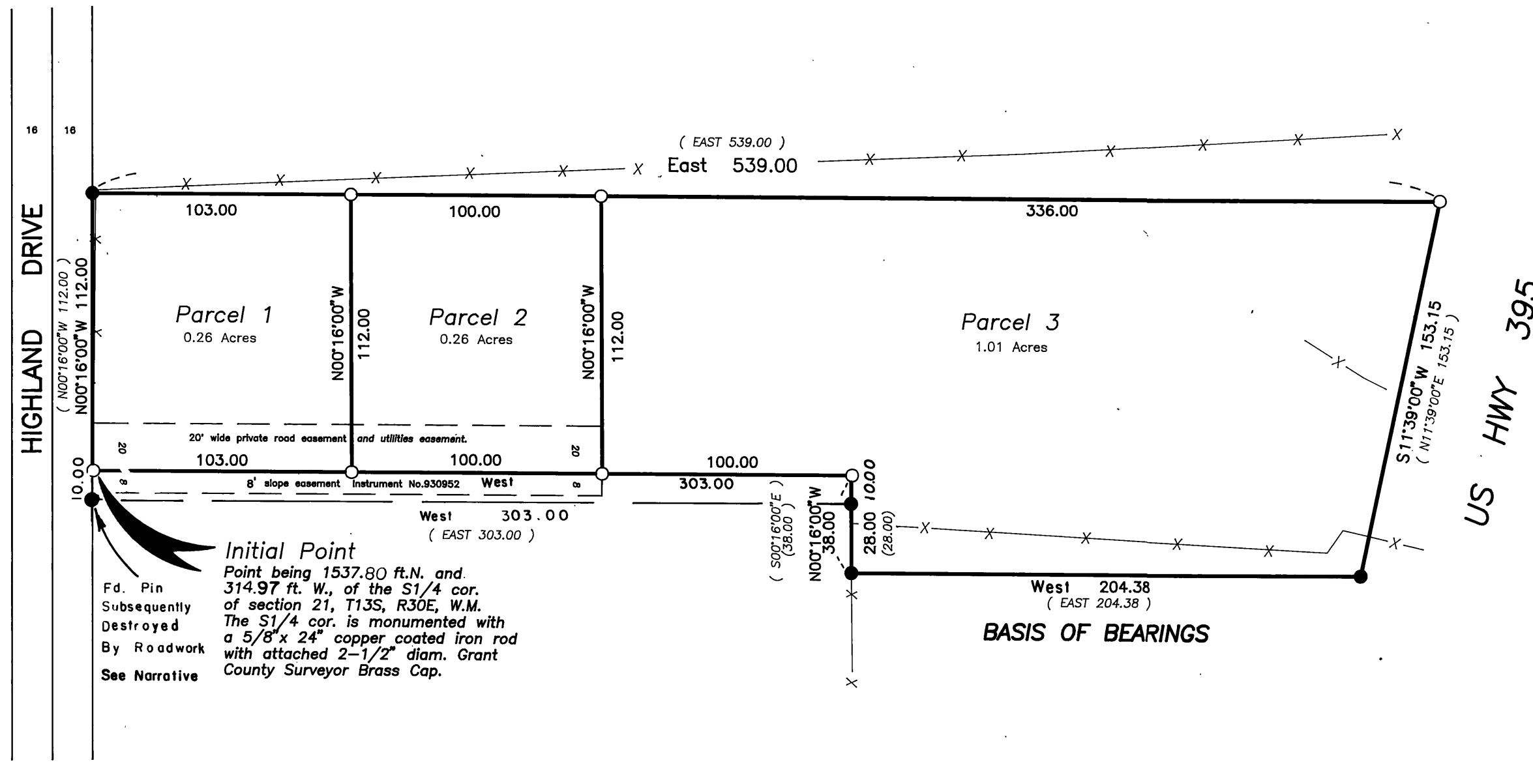

I, Robert D. Bagett, Professional Land Surveyor, registered in the State of Oregon, hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments, the land represented as shown on this partition plat, said partition being situated in the NW1/4SE1/4 and NE1/4SW1/4 of Section 21, Twp.13S., R.30E., W.M., City of Mt. Vernon, Grant County, Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at the 5/8"x30" iron pin, which point I designate to be the Initial Point for this Land Partition, said point being 1537.47 feet North and 315.51 feet West from the South 1/4 corner of said Section 21, thence N.00°16'00"W., 112.00 feet; thence East 539.00 feet to a point on the westerly right of way line of U.S. Highway 395; thence S.11°39'00"W., along said westerly right of way line 153.15 feet; thence West, 204.38 feet; thence N.00°16'00"W., 38.00; thence West 303.00 feet to the point of beginning.

NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Don Cates. The purpose of this survey was to delineate PARCELS 1, 2, and 3 of this Land Partition as shown hereon.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate existing monuments. New monuments were set in accordance with the evidence found and at locations approved by Mr. Cates at the corners on the division line between said parcels, as shown.

This survey is a retracement of Survey No. 164 which basically established the exterior boundary, of the Cates tract.

During this current survey we ran a closed loop control traverse and tied the controlling monumented corners as shown hereon. Five of the original six monuments of Survey No. 164 were found as shown hereon, the SW corner was destroyed in road construction by Mr. Cates after we made our initial retracement survey. The NE corner was missing. We reset the NE corner at it's original position based on the record measurements of Survey No. 164.

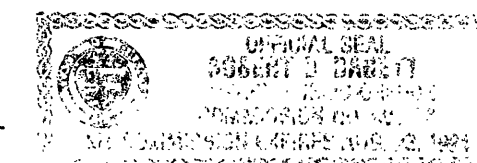
