

traverse and tied the controlling monumented corners as shown hereon. Five of the original six monuments of

Survey No. 164 were found as shown hereon, the SW corner was destroyed in road construction by Mr. Cates

after we made our initial retracement survey. The NE

corner was missing. We reset the NE corner at it's original position based on the record measurements of
