NARRATIVE: This survey was performed at the request of Jim Walker, Assistant County Road Supervisor, acting in behalf of the County Road Department. The purpose of this survey was to delineate an area for a proposed rock storage lease site.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate the existing right of way monuments on County Road No. 63, as shown. This survey is tied to a Grant County Surveyor brass capped iron pipe monument at the Southwest corner of Section 17, which I remonumented from original evidence in 1994.

New monuments were set at locations approved by Mr. Walker, as shown hereon. I found no unusual conditions during this survey.
