

Narrative:

This survey was performed at the request of Royal Allen. The purpose of this survey was to monument a new boundary line between Garry Allen and Royal Allen.

After searching the available records pertaining to this survey, I found that the south and east lines were monumented in 1974, see Record Map of Survey No. 329, filed in the office of the Grant County Surveyor. The monuments of Survey No. 329 on the northerly boundary were not recovered, I believe they were lost due to construction in this area. In 1994, a monument was set on an extension of Mr. Allen's east boundary see Record Map of Survey No. 1346. We recovered this on an extension of Mr. Allen's east boundary, see Record Map of Survey No. 1346. We recovered this monument and the monument set at the southeast corner in Survey No. 329 to establish the east

The north and west lines were established at positions agreed upon by Royal Allen and Garry Allen, the adjoining land owner. The north boundary of the highway has been established in various surveys thru the years, we used the same bearing rotation that has been applied to the highway centerline bearing in those previous surveys to set the southwest corner on the highway right of way line.

This survey was performed with a Topcon GTS-4 total station, with a closed loop random traverse. I used a IBM compatible AST Brovo 486 computer and CG Survey software to perform the calculations.
