
Narrative

This survey was performed at the request of Keith Charles. The purpose of this survey was to monument the property lines as described in Deed Instrument No. 981526.

After searching the available records pertaining to this survey, I found that the controlling corners of sections 24 and 25 have all been remonumented with the exception of the S1/4 corner of Section 25. This corner was searched for and no evidence of the original corner was found. I set the S1/4 corner of Section 25 at single proportion between the found corners 1/2 mile east and west. Section 25 was divided in the usual manner and the corners of Mr. Charles's property were established as shown.
