This survey was performed at the request of Eric Nansen. The purpose of this survey was to retrace the north boundary of Sections 1 and 2, and the north boundary of Gov't Lot 1 of Section 3, for the purpose of marking the line for fencing.

After searching the available records pertaining to this survey, I found Survey No. 131, done by the BLM in 1960 and Survey No. 1521, which was a portion of this survey. I marked the line between the found monuments as shown hereon. No new monuments were established during this survey. This survey map was prepared at the request of Mr. Nansen to record the measurements between the found corners.
