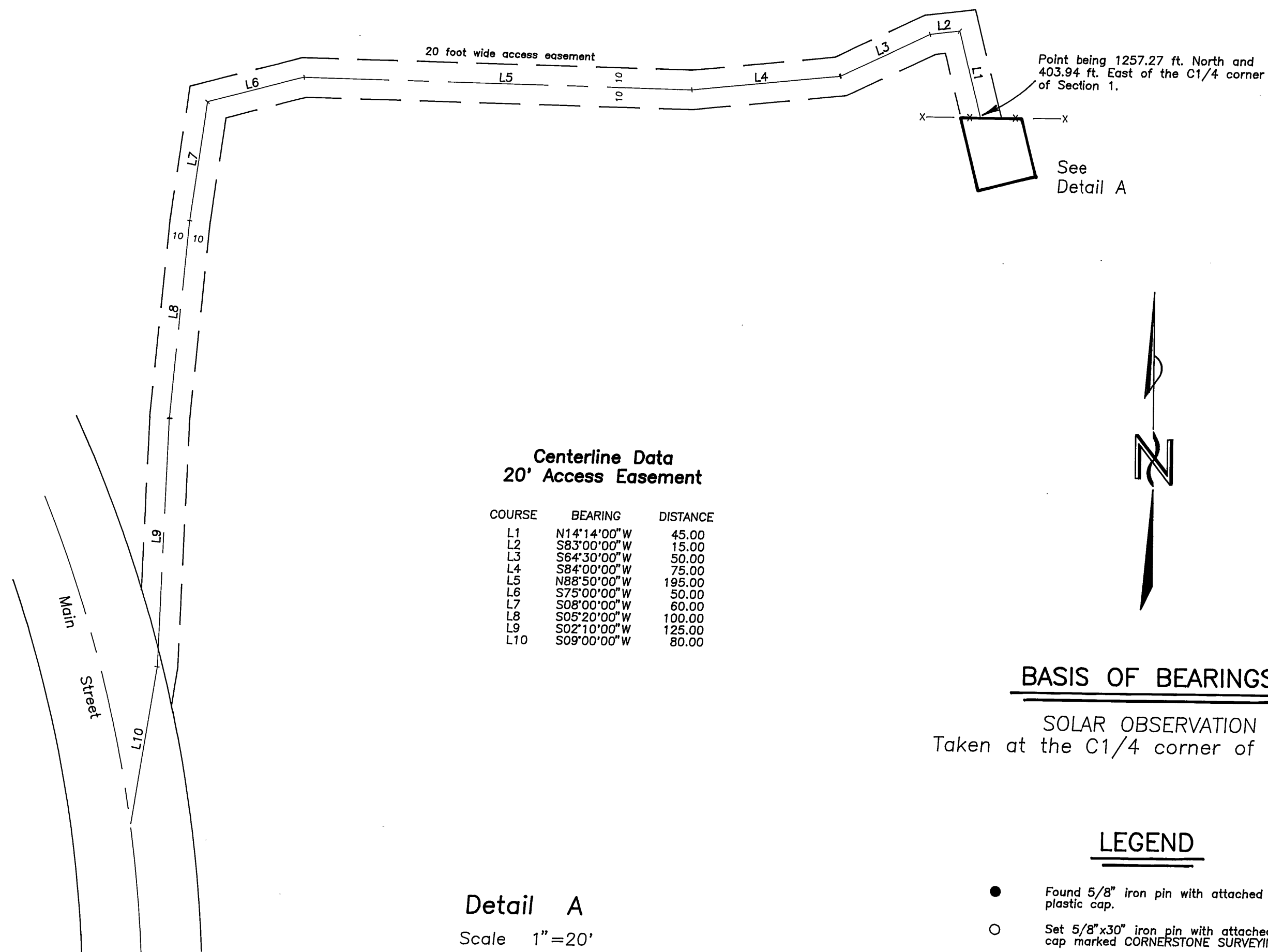


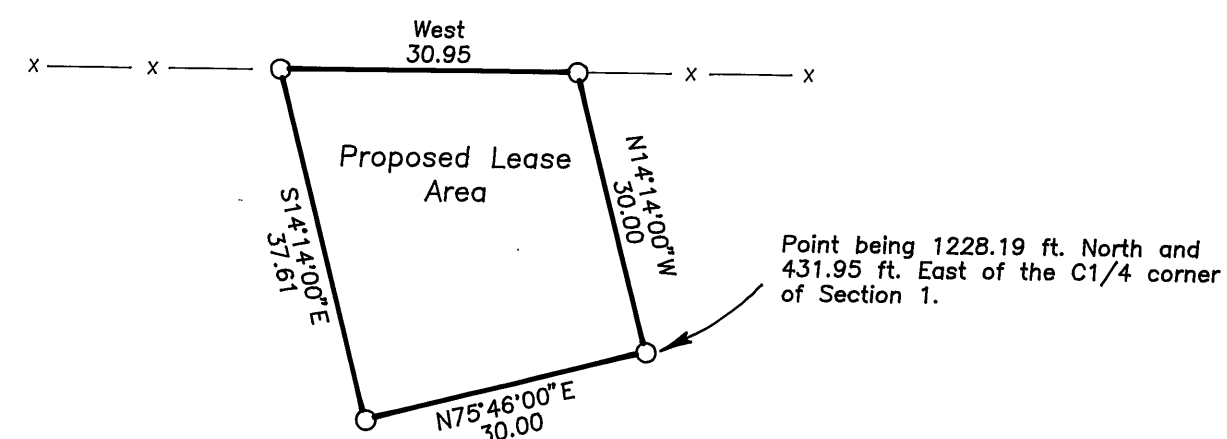
Cox Lift Station Site

Note: The C1/4 corner of Section 1 is monumented with a Grant County Surveyor brass cap set in concrete.

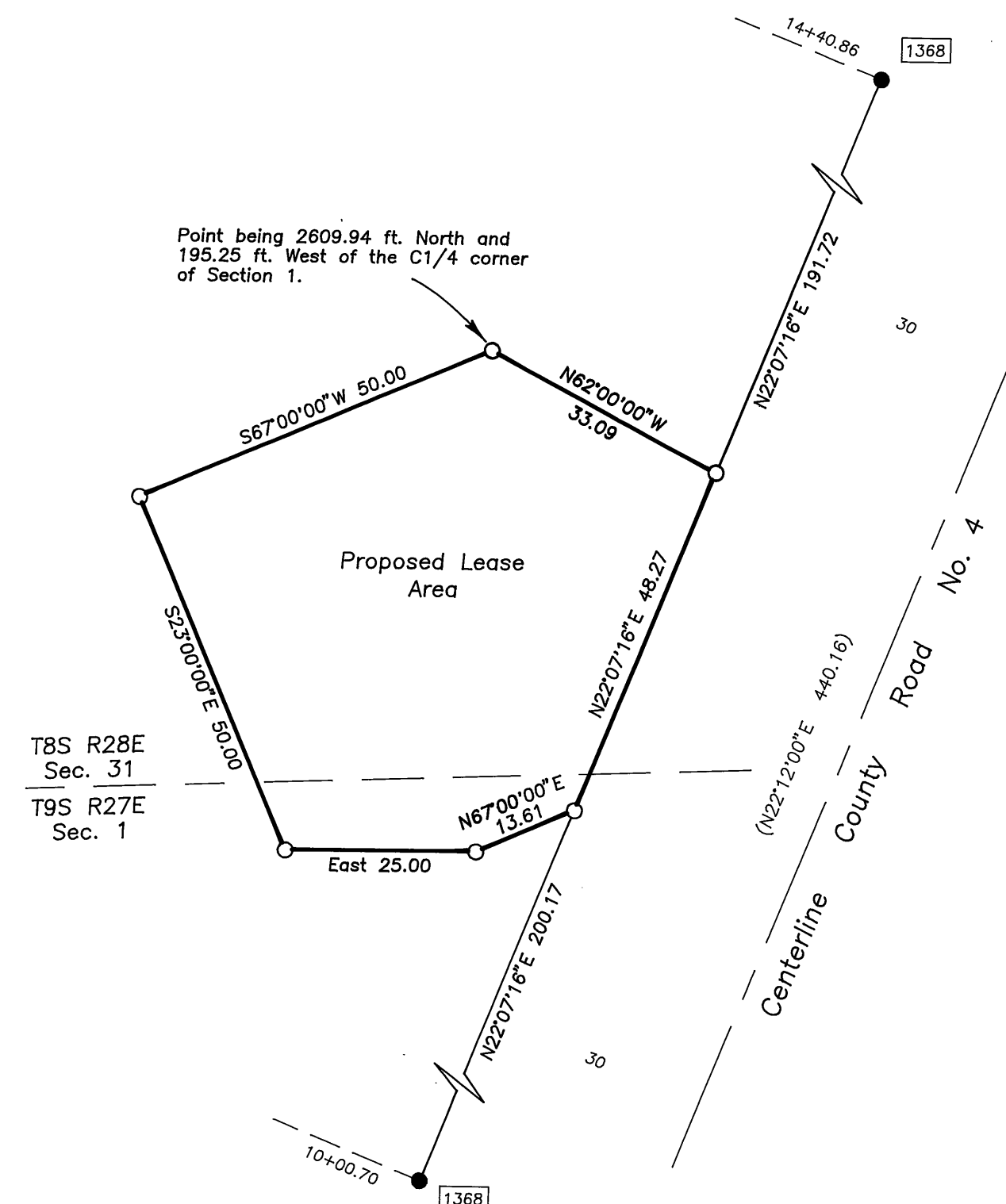
NARRATIVE
