## BASIS OF BEARINGS

RECORD MAP OF SURVEY NO. 990

- Found 2½" aluminum pipe with attached 3½" alum. cap marked as shown, see Survey No. 990, unless otherwise shown.
- Set 5/8"x30" iron pin with attached red plastic cap marked CORNERSTONE SURVEYING, INC.
- Survey No. 398, record bearing and distance.
- Survey No. 990, record bearing and distance.

### NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Richard Stanfill. The purpose of this survey was to survey and monument an adjusted property line.

After searching the available records pertaining to this survey, I found that the property corners have been set in previous surveys. Survey No. 990, performed by Douglas Ferguson in April of 1987, is the most recent survey. I found and accepted the corners from Survey No. 990 as shown. I set monuments on the new division line at the position chosen by Mr. Stanfill. I also located the center line of Canyon Creek as shown.
