
- Found 2½" aluminum pipe with attached 3" aluminum cap of Record. See Land Corner Monumentation Sheet.

NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Roger Lang. The purpose of this survey was to establish and monument the boundaries of Mr. Lang's property as described in Deed Instrument No. 993302.

After searching the available records pertaining to this survey, I found Record Land Corner Monumentation sheets for the SE and NE corners of Section 34. These two corners had been remonumented from original evidence on July 8, 1999.

I found the original corner stones at the NW and SW corners of Section 34 and remonumented them. I found no evidence at any of the four 1/4 corners and set them using the single proportionate measurement method. The section was subdivided in the usual manner and the corners of Mr. Lang's property were established.
