- Survey No. 496 record bearing and distance.

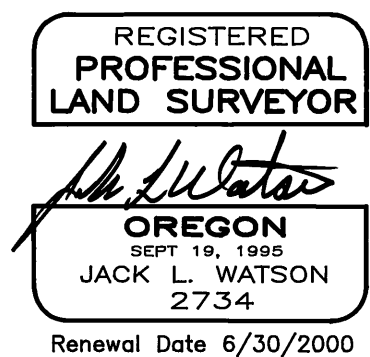
## NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Mike Browning. The purpose of this survey was to locate and monument a property adjustment line which was mutually agreed upon by the adjoining property owners.

After searching the available records pertaining to this survey, I found the Seneca plat dated March 19, 1930 and Survey No. 496, dated January 6, 1978. I found several monuments from Survey No. 496 which I accepted to position the boundaries of block 18. The new division line was monumented along the agreement line.
