NARRATIVE

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF RICK MILLER, ACTING IN BEHALF OF PINE TELEPHONE SYSTEM, INC. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO RESET THE IRON PIN MONUMENT AT THE NE CORNER OF THE UNNUMBERED BLOCK IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE, AS SHOWN.

THIS PIN WAS REMOVED DURING CONSTRUCTION OF THE BURIED TELEPHONE CABLE.

A SEARCH WAS MADE OF THE AVAILABLE RECORDS PERTAINING TO THIS SURVEY. FIELD MEASUREMENTS WERE MADE TO LOCATE STREET CENTERLINE MONUMENT NO. 8 OF RECORD SURVEY NO. 1285 AND THE CONTROLLING MONUMENTS ESTABLISHED IN RECORD SURVEY NO. 1519, AS SHOWN.

WE FOUND THE ORIGINAL PIN LYING ON THE GROUND NEARBY. I RESET THE SAME PIN IN ITS ORIGINAL POSITION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE EVIDENCE FOUND AND CONTROLLED BY RECORD SURVEY NO. 1519, WHICH I PERFORMED FOR PINE TELEPHONE SYSTEM IN JUNE 1999.
