NARRATIVE

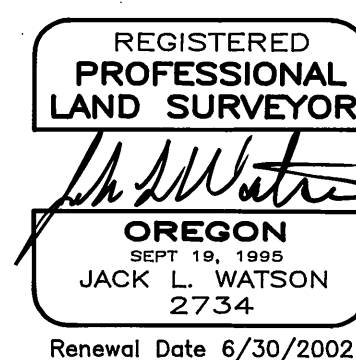
This survey was performed at the request of Rick Page. The purpose of this survey was to establish the CW1/16 corner and the W1/16 corner on the south boundary of Section 34.

After searching the available records pertaining to this survey, I found Survey No. 1540, dated December 27, 1999. Survey No. 1540 is a subdivision of Section 34. I found and excepted the monuments of Survey No. 1540, as shown. The CW1/16 corner was set on line and at the mid-point between the C1/4 corner and the W1/4 corner. The W1/16 corner was set on line and at the mid-point between the S1/4 corner and the SW corner of Section 34.
