- ( ) GLO record bearing and distance.


## NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Gordon Lemons. The purpose of this survey was to establish the east line of the SE1/4 of Section 28.

I made a search of the available records pertaining to this survey. Several corners have been recovered and remonumented in Section 28. I recovered the original corner stone at the E1/4 corner and positioned the SE section corner at record distance from the GLO topo calls north and west of the corner. I set the S1/16 corner on line and at the mid—point between these two corners.
