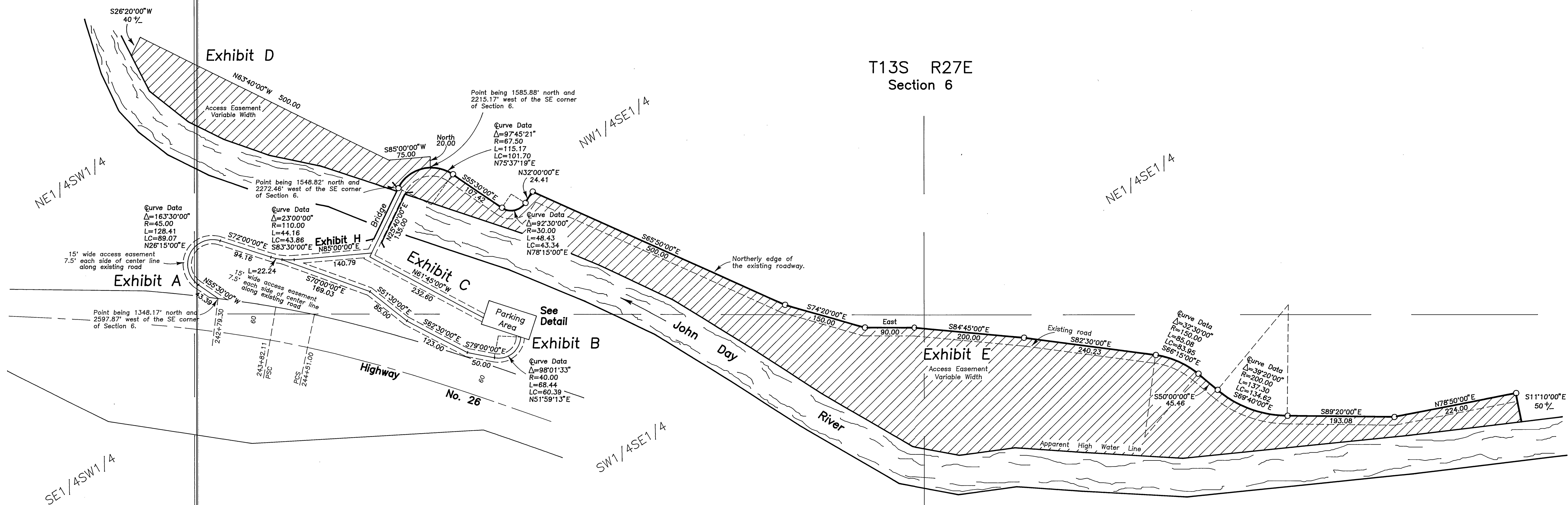

Dimensions for the access easements shown as Exhibits A, C and H are center line dimensions.

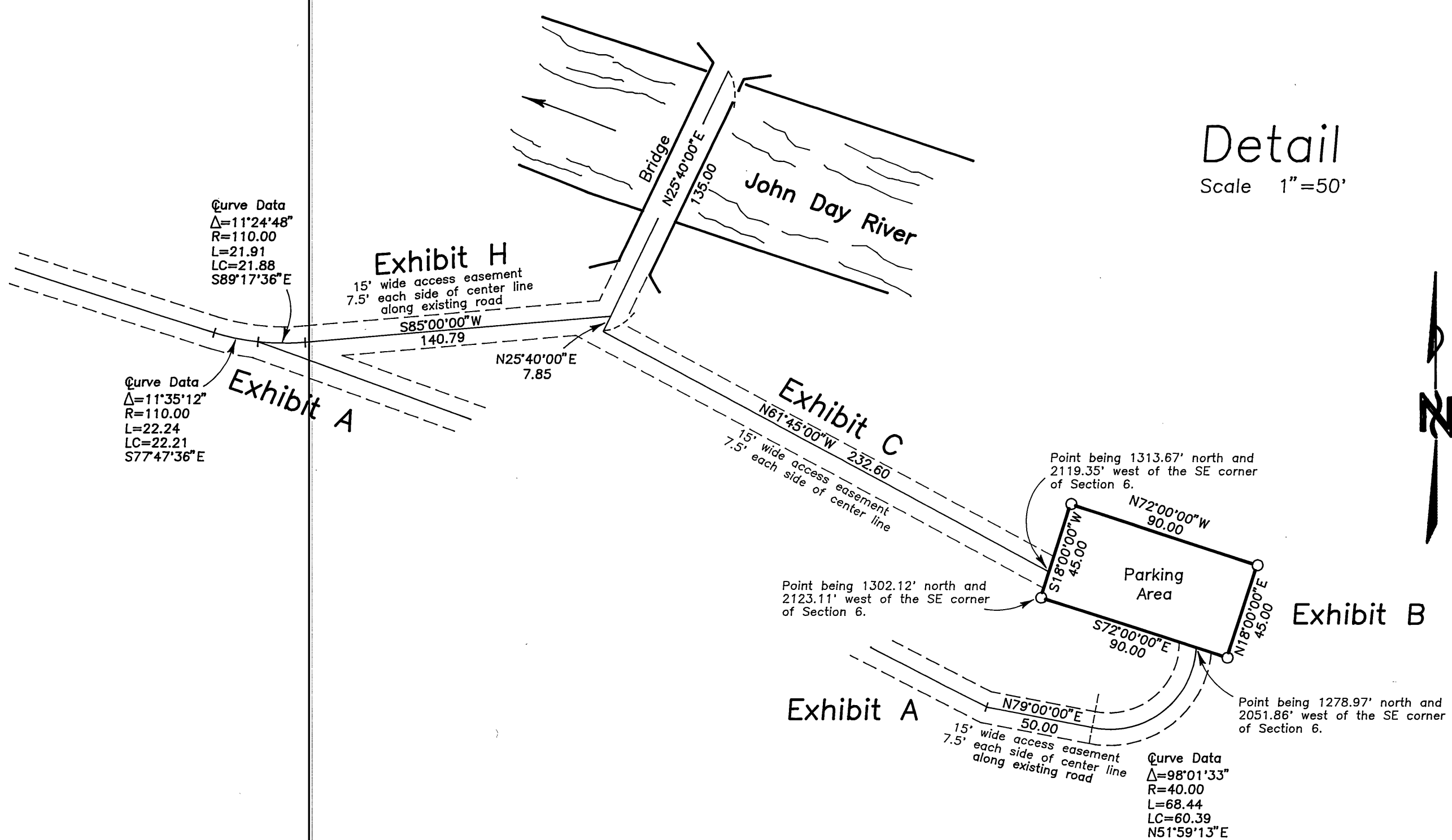
The SE corner of Section 6 is monumented with a 1" iron pipe with attached brass cap, see Survey No. 76.

Section 6 was not subdivided, the subdivision of section lines are shown in their approximate location for informational purposes only.

NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Lynne Perry, of the Oregon Department of Justice, on behalf of the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife. The purpose of this survey was to locate the easements as shown.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey, field measurements were made to locate the existing roads and easement locations as agreed upon and pointed out to me by Lynne Perry, Dave Harcombe, and Loren Stout. Land Partition No. 98-15, dated March 18, 1998 shows an access easement which generally follows the location of Exhibits A and H. The access easement shown on Land Partition No. 98-15 will be abandoned along with the parking area. New descriptions have been prepared that describe the easements shown on this plat.

The monuments set on the north boundary of Exhibit E are along the north sideline of an existing road. The monuments at the corners of the parking area shown as Exhibit B, are at positions pointed out to me by David Harcombe, on behalf of the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, and Loren Stout the landowner.
