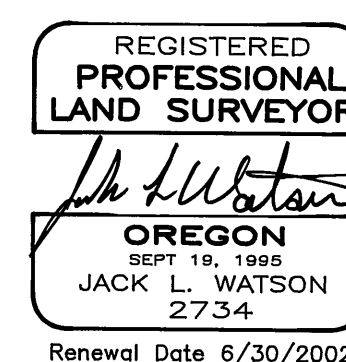
NARRATIVE
