NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of John Thomas. The purpose of this survey was to locate the boundaries of a proposed boundary line adjustment. The proposed boundaries were chosen by Mr. Thomas.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey and for the monuments of Survey No. 1483. The highway centerline was located and monuments were set 40 feet from the existing centerline. An offset monument was set near the high water line of the river and on the north line of Section 30.
