## **NARRATIVE**

This survey was performed at the request of George Meredith. The purpose of this survey was to monument and mark the proposed boundary agreement line shown hereon.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey and for the appurtenant monuments on the boundary. The monument on the north line of Section 2 was set between the NW corner and N1/4 corner of Section 2, as shown on Survey No. 1626. The proposed boundary line is established where the adjoining landowners agreed. The southerly monument was set on line between the C1/4 corner and the SE1/16 corner established in Survey No. 1626.
