

NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Richard Naumann. The purpose of this survey was to establish the S1/16 corner on the east line of Section 24.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. Field measurements were made to locate the E1/4 corner and SE corner of Section 24. The S1/16 corner was set at the mid—point and on line between these corners. A corner restoration sheet was recorded separately for the S1/16 corner.
