NARRATIVE

This survey was performed at the request of Carl Johns. The purpose of this survey was to establish the corners of Lots 1 and 4, Block C, and a line along an existing fence which runs through Lot 2.

After searching the available records pertaining to this survey, I found Survey No. 714, and Survey No. 787 which I used to establish the required corners. I recovered the monument at the initial point of Railroad Addition, and the monuments from Survey 714. I searched for the 1/2" bolt at the SW corner of Railroad Addition which is shown on Survey No. 787 at the initial point of Taylor's Addition, but it was not found. The lots of Block C were proportioned in accordance with the excess on the west boundary of Railroad Addition as shown on Survey No. 787.
