

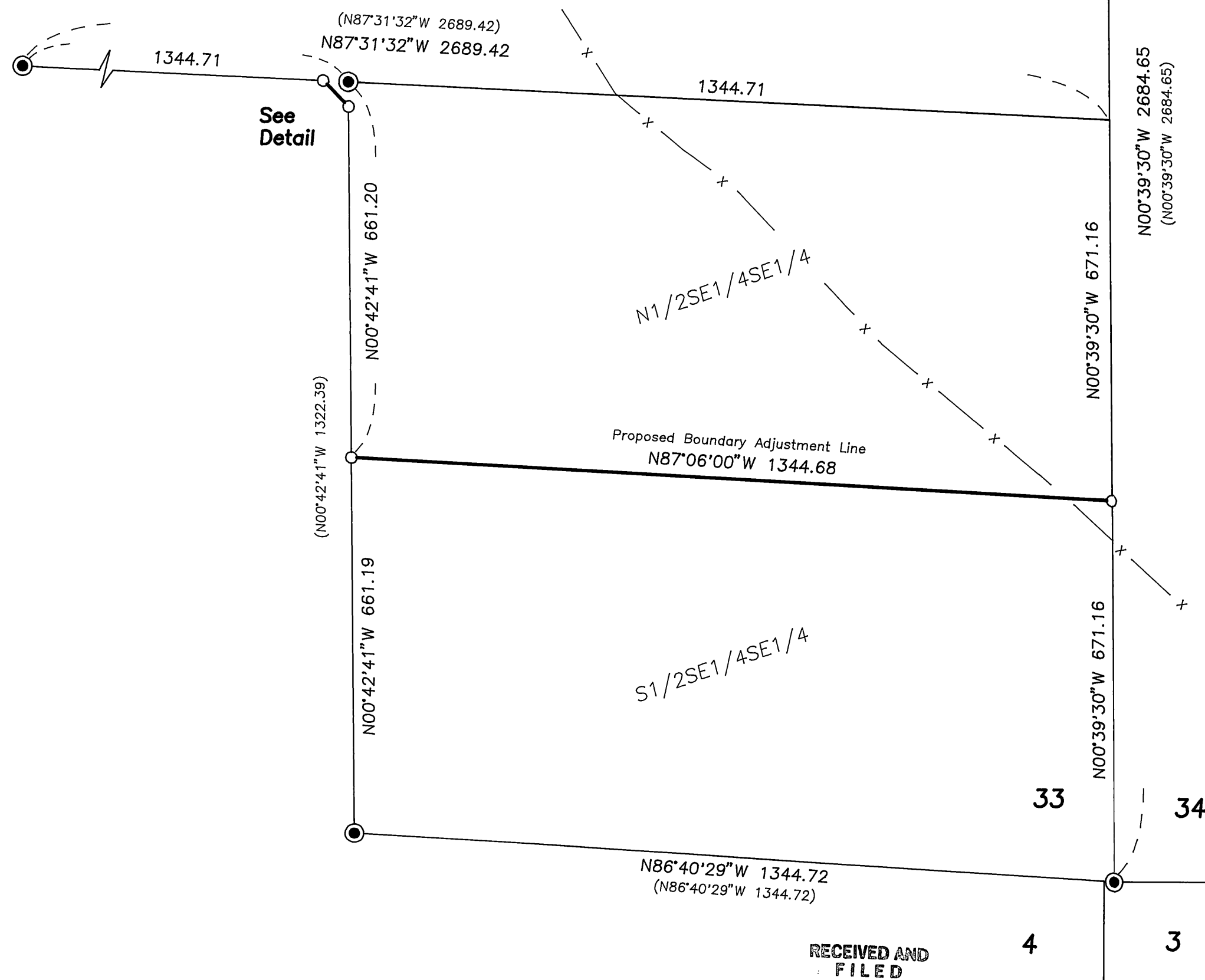

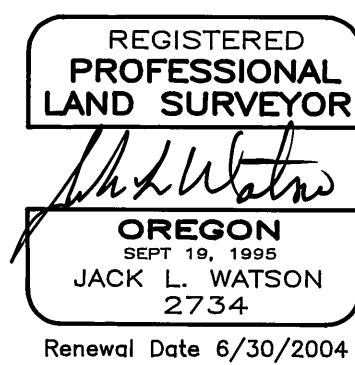
NARRATIVE
