This survey was performed at the request of Penny Bennett. The purpose of this survey was to establish the proposed boundary adjustment as shown. The entire property is described in Instrument No. 203032, deeds of Grant County, Oregon.

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey and field measurements were made to locate the monuments shown. The new monuments were set in accordance with the evidence found. The county road right of way alignment shown on Survey No. 717 was used. The proposed boundary line was extended to intersect this right of way.
